


the people chose. We have

As they work together to solve the pop star's murder, Lucifer is struck by Chloe's inherent goodness. Accustomed to dealing with the absolute worst of humanity, Lucifer is intrigued by Chloe's apparent purity and begins to wonder if there's hope for his own soul yet. At the same time, God's emissary, the angel AMENA-DIEL, has been sent to Los Angeles to convince Lucifer to return to the underworld...can the Devil incarnate be tempted toward the side of Good, or will his original calling pull him back toward Evil?"

James 1:13-17 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: 14
But every man is tempted,
when he is drawn away of his
own lust, and enticed. 15
Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin:
and sin, when it is finished,
bringeth forth death. 16 Do
not err, my beloved brethren.
17 Every good gift and every
perfect gift is from above, and
cometh down from the Father
of lights, with whom is no
variableness, neither shadow
of turning.

ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION

"The idol of the desolator", or "the idol that causeth desolation" Abomination refers especially to such idolatry only as is perpetrated by apostates from Jehovah (2 Kings 21:2-7; 23:13). The Lord quotes Dan 9:27; 11:31; 12:11, in Matt 24:15 "the abomination of desolation", as the sign of Jerusalem's coming destruction. Daniel makes the ceasing of the sacrifice and oblation the preliminary to it. Jewish rabbis considered the prophecy fulfilled when the Jews erected an idol altar, described as "the abomination of desolation" in 1 Macc. 1:54; 6:7. This was necessarily followed by the profanation of the temple under the Old Testament antichrist, Antiochus Epiphanes. He built an idolatrous altar on the altar of burnt offering to Jupiter Olympius, and dedicated the temple to him, and offered swine's flesh. This sacrificing of an UNCLEAN pig was the worst kind of abomination that could

have taken place. The prophecy in the Gospels of Matthew and Mark was also believed fulfilled when the Romans through V espasian desecrated and destroyed the Jewish Temple about A.D. 70."

Those are two physical, historical events both prophesied and fulfilled

That being said, I think we need to look deeper into Jesus' meaning of temple. John 2:19-22
Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up. 20
Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days?21 But he spake of the temple of his body. 22 When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and

they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said.

1 Cor 3:16-17 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? 17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.

The temple is the body of Christ...the church is the body of Christ. The antichrist will, to quote satan, "...sit also upon the mount of the congregation (body of Christ)..." Isa 14:13

prayers had been as well as on the exact season of New Year's Eve prayer meeting...God's Spirit drops a foreign word into my heart...Beshert/beschert. I have my answer from the Lord.

At this new year, my Beshert, Jesus, has given me my beschert, divine gifts, for which I sought. **Wait for it...** I was praying for ministries and churches, therefore, I am telling you that in this new year your Beshert, Jesus, is giving you your beschert, divine gifts!!!!!!! I had been seeking

"We the people" are generally a lower risk profile, thus we do not have all the protection as the president, however, we have the Constitutional, Second Amendment that gives us the right to own, keep and bear arms with the understanding that being armed prevents, protects and defends us against any violence to do us harm...as it should be.

In this nation, whether high or low risk profile, we are all considered "We The People" having the same rights of protection, if not the same degree or extent, at least the right.

As I was listening to a media minister talk about the only True Church, which of course was his denomination, God's Spirit turned me over to Rev 2-3. As I read those chapters again, it became quite clear that I was not too far off base with my thinking. Jesus was addressing seven churches...seven very different churches with different circumstances and surroundings. I noticed that He did not point out any one of them as truer than the others, but instead commended them each upon their good points and pointed out their flaws for correction. I have come to understand that God is neither impressed by our denominational titles nor is He dismayed by them. His only purpose, as I read from the address, is that we are to be steered toward His heart.

These same churches live on today under different titles. It is rather like a litmus test to see if we have gone outside of God's Will and intent for us.

Ministers, who only fault other church affiliations promoting themselves in doing so, are missing the mark of Christianity and playing the rhetoric card in likeness to political campaigners who only tell you what is wrong with everyone else. Isa 52:7 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth!

That says nothing about criticizing other faiths, while the hungry go away more starved still. There is only one Way, Truth and Life and that is found in Christ Jesus. It is

upon His name we build our faith, trust and have our testimony. The Lutheran, Methodist, Evangelical, Pentecostal, Seventh Day Adventist, Presbyterian or Charismatic non-denominational churches etc., etc. are not the way, truth or life, yet are to be a light shining in the darkness to point the way to HIM. We are to discern our own flaws and correct them. I have enough to do just correcting my own self so that my life may be lived in front of others in truth and not just as a good act. After all, the definition of character is what a person is when no one is looking.

Rom 14:22 You may have the faith to believe that there is nothing wrong with what you are doing, but keep it between yourself and God. Blessed are those who do not condemn themselves by doing something they know is all right. NLT

Keep the little differences from afflicting others with a condemnation not belonging to them, while instead present the Good News of Hope to a hopeless world.
