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Tu B'Shevav And The Moon 2018-2019

The "super, moon-blood moon" which took place on January 31 was also a total lunar eclipse that I wrote about in Jan. 2018, Issue. This was the first time of occurrence in 150 years. I studied whether it would happen on a Jewish celebration/season and found Tu B'Shevav. Remember what makes a heavenly sign significant is when a sign and season collide, Gen 1:14. The eclipse took place on Tu B'Shevav, the biblical calendar, the fifteenth day of the month of Shevat. This is important because that eclipse was only one of a series. The next one is this month on July 27, which is Tu B'Av or the fifteenth of Av on the biblical calendar, followed by one January 21, 2019 – which just so happens to be Tu B'Shevav again.

To refresh your mind, Tu B'Shevav is the time of budding trees, Lev 19:22-25. Trees are symbolic for God's people as well as leaders of nations, etc.. *Ps 1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.*

The Scriptures often refer to His children being as trees bearing good fruit, John 15:16. Then we see this: *Deut 20:20 Only the trees which thou knowest that they be not trees for meat, thou shalt destroy and cut them down...*We remember Jesus showed the action of a hidden meaning: *Matt 21:19 And when he saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever. And presently the fig tree withered away.* The fig tree here was not giving its fruit in its season. This was a spiritual sign of religion/Pharisees during the time of God on earth in which they conflicted yet are no more. The sect of Pharisees were cut down at the same time period as the temple being destroyed...that fig tree withered: *Matt 7:19 Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.*

In 2018-2019 we see a three-fold cord of events and a three-fold cord is not

easily broken meaning there is significant strength in this succession of signs in the heavens.

There are so many signs in the heavens that we have witnessed, read or heard about, but let me center my attention on the significance of Tu B'Shevav during these blood moon eclipses.

First we have the recognition of it being a time of budding, fruit trees as identifying with a season change. The earliest tree to bud is the almond tree. The almond tree is scattered throughout the Scriptures having to do with both miracles and authority as well as judgment that comes with rebellion as we remember Aaron's rod. Etc.

Also notice this prophecy: *Zech 1:7-16 Upon the four and twentieth day of the eleventh month, which is the month Sebat, in the second year of Darius, came the word of the LORD unto Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet, saying, 8 I saw by night, and behold a man riding upon a red horse, and he stood among the myrtle trees that were in the bottom; and behind him were there red horses, speckled, and white. 9 Then said I, O my lord, what are these? And the angel that talked with me said unto me, I will shew thee what these be. 10 And the man that stood among the myrtle trees answered and said, These are they whom the LORD hath sent to walk to and fro through the earth. 11 And they answered the angel of the LORD that stood among the myrtle trees, and said, We have walked to and fro through the earth, and, behold, all the earth sitteth still, and is at rest. 12 Then the angel of the LORD answered and said, O LORD of hosts, how long wilt thou not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these threescore and ten years? 13 And the LORD answered the angel that talked with me with good words and comfortable words. 14 So the angel that communed with me said unto me, Cry thou, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts: I am jealous for*

Jerusalem and for Zion with a great jealousy. 15 And I am very sore displeased with the heathen that are at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction. 16 Therefore thus saith the LORD: I am returned to Jerusalem with mercies: my house shall be built in it, saith the LORD of hosts, and a line shall be stretched forth upon Jerusalem.

Notice the relevance of the time of Shevat or "Time of Trees" and identified as not only a season change but the second year of a new administration, but also the red horse, which has always symbolized the taking away of peace. Also notice that Zechariah's vision is the 70 years after Christ when Israel is no longer a nation. We are at 70 years after Israel's rebirth, 1948. God's attention goes to Jerusalem. Do you see the correlation of the signs in heaven with the season? Only God could orchestrate these "Coincidences".

Zech 1:18-21 Then lifted I up mine eyes, and saw, and behold four horns. There is a group called the Quartet, which includes the UN, US, EU and Russia who have formed as a proctor for peace mediations between Israel and Palestine, however, they have kept Israel from the boundaries God has given. So the Lord showed Zechariah 4 carpenters to "fray", which means to discomfit, the four horns, while continuing in the next chapter to show that God Himself will declare and stretch the boundaries. When Trump began the process of moving the US embassy to Jerusalem as the declared capital of Israel, it discomfited the progress of the four horns and infuriated the Palestinian leadership as well as years of apathy in the US to act upon it.

In a nut-shell what I am seeing has to do greatly with Jerusalem and getting her into her end-time position. Even though I regard Jesus as the raised temple, the nation of Israel has been planning their temple construction. I also see throughout Scripture the blessings incurred by those who support Jerusalem and curses of those who come against her, which brings me

to the last thing I perceived by the Holy Spirit. I see that just as Haman built the gallows for Mordechai any national leader building the gallows against Israel will hang from them.

During the time of Tu B'Shevav all trees not bearing good fruit will be cut down. Maybe not in one day or one big swoosh, but it will happen.

I do not believe Christendom in all her excitement of fulfilled prophecy realizes the condition of things to come. These are not the peaceful times many may expect. We live in a "convenience seeking" atmosphere with many labeling themselves as Christians who are out of the loop where the Word of God is concerned. The knowledge in the Word that they do not seek after, they do not have.

Though God is all about the welfare of His children, He is not a welfare system. Christians have a part in the scheme of things. There are no bystanders. Christianity is not a spectator sport with time to sit out in the bleachers judging what the participants should have done better. What would have happened had Noah sat that time out waiting for God to rapture him: *Ezek 14:14 Though these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they should deliver but their own souls by their righteousness, saith the Lord GOD... 16 Though these three men were in it, as I live, saith the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither sons nor daughters; they only shall be delivered, but the land shall be desolate... 20 Though Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, as I live, saith the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither son nor daughter; they shall but deliver their own souls by their righteousness.*

These three men were in it...went through it...came out of the other side of it, but were not taken out of it. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego were well in it. We, who are alive, will be in it, but like the faithfully prepare...we will come through it to the other side yet not by accident but commitment.
