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# Spontaneous Prayers Answered

At a community meeting there was a discussion on when God says, “No.” Of course, I do not believe God says that, since God said “Yes and Amen” to all of His promises.

I do believe that rigid prayers will not see many answers if any because they do not bend toward God but toward the things a person is praying.

I have found when praying for change that unless I am willing to be part of the change, I may not see the answer. More than not, no matter the situation, the biggest adjustment is me, myself and I.

I believe in spontaneous praying. Let me explain it like this: spontaneous means—unplanned, unrehearsed and uninstructed. When I pray about something that needs an answer, I do not plan how the answer goes or rehearse it as if writing its script, and I never instruct God on the details. In other words, I do not interpret God...He interprets me. I allow Him to prepare me to receive it.

A good example in my personal life was a situation where my feelings had been hurt by someone, and I distanced myself from her. Sitting in church one Sunday, forgiveness must have been mentioned and with that

her face came to mind. In my thinking, I told the Lord that even though I had done nothing to receive that treatment I chose to forgive. I thought I had justified myself fairly and objectively. The next thought was a spontaneous thought that gave me a picture of two people pulling a rope in a tug of war accompanied with the understanding to drop my side of the rope. How simple. I did not have to wait for an apology. I simply had to drop my side of the rope and let it go. I knew the thought was God because it was not my plan or the way I had rehearsed my side of justification.

***Isa 55:9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.***

Recognize those spontaneous thoughts as God’s voice shedding light on a better way. His thoughts are higher than ours and the answers we are searching are right there if we will pay attention. You could be missing the very inner voice of God giving you guidance to help the process along, but let Him do the leading. Another time the prayer was over finances. There was an amount of money due that we did not have. I had no clue of how we would ever have it...BUT GOD. I am smart enough to realize that I had

no clue...meaning I had no direction to point out to God or instruct Him how He should work. I just believed Him. (Having said that, the wait can be a scary one if you tend to wonder whether or not God hears you or has His mind on bigger miracles to perform!!) Leave it all up to God and have Him be the focus and not the situation. Something rather funny happened the next day after we had prayed. I went to the mailbox and there was an envelop, junk mail, with a nickel attached inside. They sent this out by the hundreds or thousands in my thinking...but one of those spontaneous thoughts came saying, “The rest is one its way!” God was winking and letting me know that He was on it! God often sends a sign and a wink to let you know, but if you are in doubt of God and pray a skeptical prayer you will miss both sign and wink. When you flow with God it is like a perfect dance with only God in the lead, you do the following and no toes get crushed.

Why would you pray to God unless you need someone greater than you to direct the answer?

Let me throw this in as well:

***Matt 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things***

***shall be added unto you.***

In anything you pray, no matter how great the situation never fix your eyes more on the problem. The problem is not fixed on itself but fixed on God therefore, the focus must be on God. Sometimes fear becomes a greater focus than God and fear is not the healer but can stop or detain the answer. The closest thing I can give as an example is praying for your children. I have a mother’s heart where my children are concerned, yet if I allow fear to be my focus it will step right in between me and God. I cannot allow fear to become the god of my focus interrupting my answer. To become divided because fear is allowing Satan “free reign to detain” and I will not see victory.

This is what Matt 6:33 is trying to tell us. With God being first in our focus, all the “things” big or small will be given.

In conclusion: When you pray keep your focus on Jesus remembering too that communication is never one sided. Those spontaneous thoughts of God’s voice should be heard and recognized.


it. God uses what He uses. He takes what is foolish to confound the wise.

## Abortion’s Big Harvest \$\$\$ Without Apology

Today we see the Democrats tout that women have a right over their bodies, which trumps the right to life for the silent majority of innocent lives. This, however, has been a smoke screen for a far more sinister plan.

Abortion did not start for the cause of women who were raped or for the problem of incest, since less than one percent is its demographic. It did not even start for the right to decide over one’s own body. No, none of those things was at its core beginning, and the end result is even more despicable than imaginable, as you will see.

Another thing Democrats do not want you to know is one of the early reasons for abortion in the U. S. included fears that the population would be dominated by the children of newly arriving immigrants, whose birth rates were higher than

those of “native” Anglo-Saxon women. Yet in the mid-to-late 1800s states began passing laws that made abortion illegal because we were a different people in a predominately Christian nation.

Here is another fact that Democrats do not want you to know on their support of Planned Parenthood. We now enter eugenics: ***Eugenics is the science of improving a human population by controlled breeding to increase the occurrence of desirable, heritable characteristics. Developed largely by Francis Galton as a method of improving the human race, it fell into disfavor only after the perversion of its doctrines by the Nazis.***

It did not fall far enough for Margaret Sanger founder of Planned Parenthood.

Let me introduce you to Sanger. On a radio show, Sanger is reported to have said that *“morons, mental defectives, epileptics, illiterates, paupers, unemployables, criminals, prostitutes, and dope fiends” ought to be surgically sterilized. If they wish, she said, such people should also be able to choose a lifelong segregated existence in labor camps.”*

There is no doubt that Sanger believed in the supremacy of the white race and the inferiority of other racial groups (for instance, she once wrote, *“It is said that the aboriginal Australian, the lowest known species of the human family, just a step higher than the chimpanzee in brain development, has so little sexual control that police authority alone prevents him from obtaining sexual satisfaction on the streets.”*

But Sanger appears to have been driven more by her views

on eugenics to reduce “undesirables” than by a motivation to eliminate specific racial groups. In other words, Sanger was obsessed with preventing the birth of people with physical and mental illnesses or who were economically disadvantaged, regardless of their race. Despite believing in the general racial superiority of the white race, Sanger preferred intelligent, middle class African Americans to illiterate, low class whites.

In 1939, Sanger, through the Birth Control Federation of America (BCFA), helped to initiate the Negro Project. Unlike many of her associates, she wanted the doctors involved in the project to be black in order to gain the trust of the African-American community.

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# Abortion's Harvest \$\$\$ continued without apology

In this objective she was joined in the Negro Project by many African-American leaders. For example, in 1939 W. E. B. Du Bois wrote in Sanger's Birth Control Review, "the mass of ignorant Negroes still breed carelessly and disastrously, so that the increase among Negroes, even more than the increase among Whites, is from that part of the population least intelligent and fit, and least able to rear their children properly. . . [the black race] must learn that among human races and groups, as among vegetables, quality and not mere quantity really counts."

In a TV interview with Mike Wallace, Sanger was asked if she believed in sin. Her reply was that the greatest sin was bringing children into the world that were deficient in one way or another, which from all her statements tells the story of a deficient society taking over what could be a more worthy elite population. (You may still find this interview with Mike Wallace and Margaret Sanger online.)

The expose videos catching Planned Parenthood officials selling the body parts of aborted babies have shocked the nation. Actual requests for body parts such as a "whole intact leg, including the entire hip joint," come with special instructions that the body be dissected by "cutting through symphysis pubis (pubic bone) and include whole illium." Additionally, a request may specify the speed at which the dissection must occur -- in this instance, that the researcher would like the body part "to be removed from the cadaver within 10 minutes." Finally, the scientists specify whether "abnormalities" are permitted and under what conditions a body part will be shipped (such as in wet or dry ice) and by what mode of transportation (usually one of the well-known overnight-delivery services). Because the sale of human tissue or body parts is prohibited by federal law, the traffickers have worked out an arrangement to expedite the process from which they all benefit and still remain

within current interpretations of the law. For instance, the harvesters receive the fetal material as a "donation" from the abortion clinic. In return, the clinic is paid a "site fee" for rental of lab space where technicians, employed by the harvesters, perform as many dissections as necessary to fill researcher manifests. The harvesters then "donate" the body parts to the researchers and, rather than pay the harvesters for the actual body parts, "donate" the cost of the retrieval (a service) via a formal price list.

Coming closer to my home in Southern Illinois, is what came to West Frankfort when Pres. Clinton lifted the ban on full term abortion etc.

Pathologist Miles Jones in West Frankfort, IL, founded Opening Lines in 1997. Jones business partner, Gayla Rose, handles its daily operations. **News item: WEST FRANKFORT, Ill.** - *In the latest and most extensive coverage of the story of the sale of aborted baby parts, World magazine reveals that one of the company's involved left town after their operation was exposed. Opening Lines, one of the companies which orchestrates the harvesting of baby parts from "abortuaries" and the sales to researchers, was forced to close up shop in the small town of West Frankfort, Illinois after the pro-life group Life Dynamics Inc. released its story to West Frankfort's newspaper.* To the right you can see the actual advertisement from a medical magazine and below the fee for their deliveries.

This whole atrocity is continuing to this very day behind closed doors. Those are the same closed doors in the dead of night that tried to impeach a president whose platform is against abortion's swamp and who has prom-

ised to drain the swamp wherever it stretches.

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# Clearing Discrepancies

Hebrew and Aramaic are sister languages, which makes them easily translated back and forth with more accuracy than many other languages. It would be related like American English to the English of England. The New Testament was written in Aramaic as this was the language Yahshua (Jesus) spoke as well as His disciples. They also spoke Hebrew but not Greek. The Greek version was translated from Aramaic. Many parts of the Old Testament are also originally Aramaic due to the captivity in eastern culture. The language in which they are written used to be called Chaldee, but is now generally known simply as Biblical Aramaic.

Hebrew thought and language sees things differently than English or Greek thought and language. Though they are not the same, it is the Greek thinking that influences today's society and impacts many of our English translations of the Bible. Many words in Hebrew do not exist in the Greek language to be translated accurately. Let me give you some examples:

*Matt 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? (KJV)*

But let's look at the Aramaic in the same verses of Scripture:

*Matt 27:46 And about the ninth hour, Jesus cried out with a loud voice and said, Eli, Eli, lemana shabakthani! My God, My God, for this I was spared! (Aramaic)* Notice the spelling is different: lama/lemana, sabachthani/shabakthani. They are close but not the same in translation.

Jesus and His disciples spoke the Galilean dialect of Aramaic. That may be why there was some confusion in what some standing by the cross believed Jesus was saying:

*Matt 27:47 Some of them that stood there, when they heard that, said, This man calleth for Elias. KJV*

Both translations from Aramaic to Greek have very different meanings. Of course, the Greek translation is mostly accepted and preached in our English form, however, we cannot take that Scripture by itself but look at all Truth to make the best judgment of which is more correct. So let's go further and look:

*John 16:32 Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. Deut 31:6 Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.*

*Heb 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.*

God has never turned His back on us and would never turn His back on His Son. To say that God cannot look upon sin is false. We are all sinners, and He knows our every thought and number of hair on our head. If He cannot look at sin, how then was He able to walk this earth among sinners? Jesus did not do anything the Father had not done: *John 5:19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.*

*Matt 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.*

What of the Good Shepherd that would leave the 99 to chase down the one, reckless, straying sheep? No, God does not turn away from sin. Where this idea came to anyone is in *Hab 1:13 Thou art of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity: wherefore lookest thou upon them that deal treacherously, and holdest thy tongue when the wicked*

*devoureth the man that is more righteous than he?*

Lookest is the word *nābat* meaning to regard with pleasure and behold is *min-nay'* meaning to consider.

Therefore, a more accurate reading would be: Thou art of purer eyes than to consider evil, and canst not regard with pleasure iniquity: wherefore take no pleasure thou upon them that deal treacherously, and holdest thy tongue when the wicked devoureth the man that is more righteous than he? Most of the Scriptures are the same wording, but where Greek does not translate well there are discrepancies.

Another discrepancy is Mt 6:13 *And lead us not into temptation (KJV)*

*And do not let us enter into temptation (Aramaic)*

There are many of these discrepancies in similarly spelled words but very different meanings: for example: *ataeth* means "I have deceived", while *ataith* means "You have deceived"

*Jeremiah 4:10 ...O Lord God, surely I have greatly deceived this people (Aramaic)*

*Jeremiah 4:10 ...Ah, Lord God! Surely thou hast greatly deceived this people (KJV)*

Also look at the words that are spelled exactly the same *gamla/gamla*, yet in the Peshitta it is rope and in the Greek it is camel. *Matt 19:24 It is easier for a rope or camel to go through the eye of a needle.* Rope definitely makes more sense, however, commentators trying to understand why a camel could be the translation made a convincing analogy that the needle Jesus was speaking of was the Needle Gate, supposedly a low and narrow after-hours entrance found in the wall surrounding Jerusalem. It was purposely small for security reasons, and a camel could only go through it by stripping off any saddles or packs and crawling through on its knees. Instead of getting the correct word

commentators must find a way for the incorrect word and meaning to fit. While camel was given an excellent analogy packed with good meaning it is nonetheless incorrect.

*Matt 7:7-8 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: 8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.*

ASK: aiteo: - ask, beg, call for, crave, desire, require.

SEEK: zeteo:- be (go) about, desire, endeavour, enquire (for), require, (X will) seek (after, for, means).

KNOCK: is to say knock in translation, however, the word of God speaks of many doors that ultimately lead to many things for man to enter. A door or gate speaks of an entrance into something that we cannot see and we have to enter by faith. In Matthew 7 the Word does not speak of a door per say, it only says to knock and "it" will be opened, and "it" covers a lot of ground!

The most important door in the Bible is Jesus, the door of the sheep and unless one enters through Him no other door will open!

When one is born again his spiritual eyes are opened to the mysteries of the kingdom of God and when one enters through the veil of separation by the washing of the blood of Jesus he becomes a new man with spiritual eyes to see into those things that even angels could not see. God wants us to see into His heavenly realm and to repent (to change ones mind) of our old fleshly ways of looking to man for spiritual answers to heavenly questions.

*"I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture." John 10:9*
