There is such a comfort in allowing Him to hold onto our hearts. Peace comes easier, since there is nothing more for us to do

but let go and release it. This is not quitting but finding that safe, rest place in trust by releasing it from our control. The mental battles we fight prove that we cannot control everything nor should we.

*God grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change...courage to change the things I can and the wisdom to know the difference.*



## Nursing What You're Rehearsing

Rehearsing is an interesting word in which we should take the time to understand. Its meaning is *to practice in order to perform*. It is the mental practice of going over and over lines of a script to get it in your mind and heart what you think and how you plan to act or give a reaction to...what or whosoever.

It is not the rehearsal that gives us as much trouble as it is the script from which one rehearses. Who is writing the script? Is anger, strife, pettiness, fear or hurt the writer? If so, I can tell you that the enemy will help author the perspective and retaliation. It will seem as if it is justification, yet viewing all dialog from the cheap seats where any Truth is too far back to see clearly.

Usually the enemy presses the buttons of our emotions for the best exaggerated viewing. It would be like looking at every-

thing from the carnival of mirrors' distortion. Reality takes a vacation and fantasy is house sitting while it is away.

This type of rehearsing is a mental sickness begetting worry, depression and anxiety. All of the "what ifs" come into play. You are followed by a cast of characters all seemingly commiserating and feeding the disease.

It is often said that the **definition of insanity** is doing the same thing over and over while expecting a different result, yet what is rehearsing by definition if not the same thing?

We do not need to borrow dialog from the enemy's playbook. Remember that the enemy's home plate is HELL, and we do not need to round that corner or set up camp there.

We like to think God has a part on our side in these little, mental skits, but He has already written

and authored what He hastens to perform.

A healthy mind is a healthy life. We cannot live other people's choices so why join in their script. There are plenty of B scripts that come along, and all it takes is reading a few lines to know it is not for you. Your success is in the Scriptures. There you find the keys to abundant life, peace and serenity. The only Script from which to rehearse is found in Jesus.

***Phil 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus...***

You will find script-yours there and a much saner place to dwell in God's presence.

***Jer 1:12 Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it.***

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# Divine Interruptions

At the end of prayer on one of the Monday night meetings in February I got two words: DIVINE INTERRUPTIONS. I understood that God's Holy Spirit was at work with divine interruptions as if an intervention in situations, governments, family members and individuals with a divine interruption of healings, deliverances and changes of all kinds. With these divine interruptions, come interventions...as surprisingly or suddenly by a confrontation of Holy Spirit power and authority!

The very next day I read a text sent by a friend with a link to John A. Kilpatrick's 2018 prophecy.

It was Tuesday early morning that I got on my computer and typed John A. Kilpatrick 2018 Prophecy to have a listen. AMAZINGLY he started by saying as he awoke December 23, the Lord gave him these words: DIVINE INTERRUPTIONS. Of course, getting this confirmation peaked my attention. I encourage you to check out his word online.

First Kilpatrick looked up interruption in Webster's, (a man after my own heart), and it said:

- \* To hinder by breaking in
- \* To yield to a higher priority
- \* To stop the execution of a plan
- \* To break continuity
- \* To impose one's will above another's
- \* To overrule what another is saying
- \* To question or remark while another is speaking

Then Kilpatrick went on with the Word: *"Tell My people I am going to break in... They are going to yield to a Higher Authority. I am going to stop the execution of the plans of the enemy. I am going to break the continuity of last year. It will not pick up with this year. It is broken off with this year. I am going to impose My Will on those who thought they have imposed their will over Mine. I am rising up, and the Holy Spirit said, I am going to overrule what another is saying. What they have*

*been saying is wrong. What they have been saying is anti-Word, anti-Christ, anti-God, and God says, I am going to rise up and let My Word and My Mind be known in all situations."*

God's children need to capitalize in prayer over what the Spirit of God is doing.

Another thing I prayed was thanksgiving for the interruptions that I did not know even happened on my behalf. There are many things that did not happen to me or you because they were averted without our awareness of it or fallout with which to deal. It may have been the simplest thought like, "Maybe I'll take this road instead of the usual route." Or maybe a prayer meeting, church or Bible study that you were not in the mood or have the energy to attend, but something made you go and after you got there knew that the meeting was just for you...it made all the difference. God is at work more than we know with little credit given back in acknowledgment.

There are going to be interruptions in health matters, finances, jobs, relationships, reputations, nations and leaders, etc.

God has a set time for plans made before the foundation of the world and any plan contrary will be interrupted and stopped.

We will see changes as if a whirlwind came through. Even those who have led in power will find they are powerless over God's plans. The normal course of things that have been long established will be changed and not return.

Mordecai's execution was interrupted and Haman was hanged on his own gallows, while Mordecai received promotion. That is what Divine Interruption looks like! In divine interruptions it is the shepherd boy with a pebble who wins over the fully armored giants and tyrants of life.

All of these interruptions will not be taken lightly by the aggressors of darkened wills and motives. Just as we are seeing the aggression and confusion in govern-

ment today, we must also remember what God's Word says: **Rev 12:12** *Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.*

Yet in all this we know: **Luke 10:19-20** *Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. 20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.*

God's Holy Spirit will be interrupting things on our behalf in the midst of it just as He did for His children in the Exodus from Egypt.

Even though I just got the words DIVINE INTERRUPTION and Kilpatrick got the same word just before the new year came, Jesus has interrupted legalism with Truth. Jesus was a grave robber. He interrupted death with life, sickness with health, and insanity with sanity. He interrupted hell by descending and taking back the keys of death, hell and the grave that we may have eternal life.

Jesus interrupted the world and it has never been the same again, but He told us that it would not be the same. Darkness fights against the light until the end: **Matt 10:34** *Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.*

We are in another season of interruption which brings the paradox of destruction and construction. Those promoters of darkness do not lie down quietly, yet will be interrupted by a Power Greater. We as God's children need to plug into His construction and remember:

**2 Cor 4:8-9** *We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; 9 Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed...*





## Relying On Past Arguments

The word for today in prayer was to let go of the successful arguments of the past. What I understood was more about religious mindsets, for example: baptisms-whether to sprinkle or immerse, tongues, healing, miracles, rapture-pre, mid or post, Old Testament vs. the New, Replacement Theology...the arguments go on with rigorous fervency, yet in truth are redundant.

I saw as if these arguments were a roadblock in the mind blocking today's revelations. Whether or not you have given or rehearsed successful arguments that you can even base Scripturally, in some cases accurately and some not so, it is time to stop traveling that worn road. God's Spirit is ever teaching us in the Word to step forward. If our mind is set backward, we miss today's understanding.

Even scientific studies recently find that often when we are forgetful it is the brain letting go of outdated material or unimportant trivia in a correcting and updating growth process relieving the brain of clutter. While leaving our glasses or cell phone in an undisclosed place makes us feel memory stupid, it does not come close to the bigger picture of things needing to be retained.

I am not saying that what we have learned from the past is irrelevant, but traveling over and over it keeps it from updating and making even clearer or possibly crippling our thinking to error. I do not know about you, but I have allowed the Holy Spirit to clarify or

correct many things I thought as a child or immature adolescent. **1 Cor 13:11-12** *When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things. 12 For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.*

Paul, Peter, and Cornelius are great examples that fit here:

**Paul:** (learned Pharisee of Pharisees-high on the food chain of religious scholars) He had God so implanted in his thinking that on the road to Damascus when God's Spirit approached him he inquired: **Acts 9:5** *Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.*

**Peter:** (disciple of Jesus, and of the core three inner circle-Peter, James, John, walked, ate, slept and worked daily with Jesus) He argued with Jesus on a rooftop saying: **Acts 10:14** *Not so, Lord; for I have never eaten any thing that is common or unclean.* The unclean in reference was the Gentiles to whom Jesus was sending him with the Gospel. Earlier Jesus had asked him three times to feed His sheep. Peter had his mind set on the Jews only, so his data was also his road block.

**Cornelius:** (Roman convert to Christianity) He was not well versed in Judaism as either Paul or Peter, yet he loved the

Lord...he and his household. When Cornelius received a vision of the Lord, he answered, **Acts 10:4** *What is it, Lord?*

◇The religious scholar: **Who art thou, Lord?** (Did not recognize God)

◇Jesus own disciple: **Not so, Lord.** (Argued with God)

◇A Roman convert: **What is it, Lord?** (Recognized God and was ready to serve.)

Are we, like Paul, allowing our knowledge to kick against the pricks? Maybe we are disciples of Christ but argue with what He is trying to show us. (Peter denied Jesus three times, was asked three times to feed God's sheep and argued with Jesus, via an angel, three times on the rooftop.) Cornelius did not have so much knowledge to unlearn, therefore, very receptive to the Spirit.

Christians tied in Scriptural arguments are really trying to win at trivial pursuit of yesterday while forfeiting the purpose driven life of today. Each current day we skip makes the future more of a challenge to understand let alone trying to live.

I am learning this for myself and giving you the opportunity to re-evaluate whether your successful arguments are worth the constant attention you are giving them, or just taking precious time away from: **Rev 3:22** *He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.*

## Hidden Faith

There was a joke about a woman that hid Jesus in her heart so well that no one suspected He was there. Wow, I can only hope the joke is not on us!!

Sometimes I think it is true that we hide Jesus and our faith so well that even we forget He is there.

**Rom 8:38-39** *For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor*

*height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*


Nothing separates God's love for us. My prayer is that nothing separates our love for Him.

My prayer for teens is that they treat God like they do their cell phones: talking to Him constantly and seeing to it that He is never out of reach but a constant consideration.





## So, Where Are We Now?



Maps help us find our way when we have no clue where we are in relation to where we are heading.

In the prophetic book of Revelation most are clueless and those scholarly studiers think they know, while none can completely agree. Jesus gave a timeline prophecy in condensed form to His disciples in Luke 21, Matt 24 and Mk 13, while He was with them. After His resurrection and return to the right hand of the Father, He gave John on the Isle of Patmos the fully detailed yet futuristic version. John not having the vocabulary of the future inventions etc. put these pictures into his inexperienced language.

A prime example is trying to describe a chopper when none existed, so you describe what you do know in your language. **Rev 9:3 And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.**

**Rev 9:7 And the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men.**

A suited man in helmet would be operating the chopper...a locust with the face of a man! These are just examples.



Could this Scripture be describing a nuclear blast with its fall out: Zech 14:12 ***And this shall be the plague where-with the LORD will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.*** This happens very quickly as people stood on their feet and not laying in a sickbed from disease.

We tend to take John's language and make nonsensical Sci-fi monsters of something futuristic, when in more likelihood he was describing the things existing in this generation.



Let's go to the end timeline in Luke 21, which is about the same as Matt 24 and Mk 13 but written for the Gentile audience.

**Luke 21:10-11 Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: 11 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven.**

Verses 10-11 tell of the things that will exist throughout the world in all generations **AFTER** Jerusalem is lost and Israel is no more from AD 70 when Vespasian's armies desecrated the temple and the Jews scattered or died.

**12 BUT BEFORE ALL OF THESE, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake. 13 And it shall turn to you for a testimony. 14 Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: 15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. 16 And ye shall be be-**

**trayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. 17 And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake. 18 But there shall not an hair of your head perish. 19 In your patience possess ye your souls. 20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh. 21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter therinto. 22 For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. 23 But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people. 24 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled.**

So, **before all of these things** in vs. 10-11, the early Christians and Jews alike would be delivered up in persecution from the times we read in the New Testament with Steven's stoning and Saul's rampage of arrests, (until his Damascus experience with his life change.)

These persecutions of the Jews progressed from the Jewish religious leaders to the Romans and so forth until the **TIME OF THE GENTILES WAS FULFILLED**: In 1949-1950 was a tetrad of back to back blood moons during Jewish feasts (Gen 1:14 lights in the firmament for signs and seasons). Jews returned to form the country of Israel for the first time in 2000 years. The next time this occurs is the Tetrad of 1967-1968. Israel captured the city of Jerusalem in the Six Day War and for the first time Jews pray at the holy wall in the city of their ancestors.

## So, Where Are We Now? continued

This is no co-incidence that Israel is still in the picture, because Jesus Himself said it, and it has happened. There has been no replacement of Jews but a re-establishment as the Word shows us.

So, back to the question: Where are we now? Let's continue in Luke 21 to see what comes after the Time of the Gentiles fulfillment:

**25 And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; 26 Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. 27 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.**

Adding verses 10-11 to 25-27 we see:

Verses 10-11 throughout the generations

- ◇ Nation against nation (earthly)
- ◇ Kingdom against kingdom (spiritually)
- ◇ Earthquakes
- ◇ Famines
- ◇ Pestilences
- ◇ Fearful sights
- ◇ Great signs from heaven

From the Time of the Gentiles fulfillment verses 25-27

- ◇ Signs in the sun, moon, stars
- ◇ Distress of nations/w perplexity
- ◇ Sea waves roaring
- ◇ Powers of heaven shaken
- ◇ Jesus' return to earth

This is Jesus' timeline not mine. (Remember if you check this out with your favorite commentaries that were written before 1948 and especially 1967, Israel is not in the picture. Eliminating Israel and Jerusalem from the picture of end times will not give you accuracy in your study.)

Verse 25 has today written all over it with many, many signs in the sun, moon and stars. Look at them in the order they came:

**1948** a year of Jubilee for the Jews and in this year they were returned to their land

**1967-1968 Tetrad:** Jerusalem was back in the hands of the re-established Israel

**2014-2015 Tetrad:** The last Blood Moon of this Tetrad was a Super Moon appearing larger than usual, and the eclipsed moon set over Jerusalem on feast days— Passover 4/15/14, Sukkot 10/8/14 and Passover 4/4/15, Sukkot 9/28/15 also in the Shemitah year. This made the ninth tetrad falling on Jewish feast days. Nine is the number of judgment.

**2015:** March 20, total solar eclipse sandwiched between the lunar eclipses of the 2014-2015 tetrad occurring just before the religious new year begins on Nisan 1 (March 21). Sept13 also 2015 total solar eclipse on Yom Teruah.

**2017:** August 21-total solar eclipse whose path was right over the U. S. , in the 1st Elul which marked a 40-day countdown to Yom Kippur, which begins the month of repentance in the God Clock. (See August 2017 Trumpet Sounds.) Then on Sept 23 also Rosh Hashanah: Signs in the Heavens, Woman Clothed with the Sun, Moon Under Her Feet And a Crown of 12 Stars on Her Head. Red Dragon of Revelation. (See Sept. 2017 Trumpet Sounds.)

**2018:** Jan 30-31 Super, blue, blood, moon eclipse, not happened in 150 years on Jewish Festival of Trees, Tu Bishvat. (See January 2018, Trumpet Sounds for more.) Those were just the high points and not every celestial happening of super moons that have been plentiful etc. I am not into astrology. Just as the Wise men followed the signs to find the Savior, we have a Savior coming back and I am watching the signs.

Going on we see the distress of nations with perplexity at what is coming on earth. To whatever this is referring leads to the **powers of heaven being shaken**.

The word heaven is *ouranos* the *sky*; by extension *heaven* (as the abode of God); by implication *happiness, power, eternity*; specifically the *Gospel (Christianity)*—To be shaken is *saleuo to waver*, that is, *agitate*; figuratively to *disturb, incite*: - move, shake (together), which can [-not] be shaken, stir up.

One thing we know is that there will be an apostasy or great falling away before Jesus returns. (2 Thess 2:3) The original word apostasia in our word apostasy; and by this term we understand a dereliction of the es-

sential principles of religious truth, either a total abandonment of Christianity itself, or such a corruption of its doctrines as renders the whole system completely inefficient to salvation. We remember how Judaism took a big hit when Jesus walked the earth as the God they did not perceive or recognize.

Whatever causes this type of apostasy even to the “way out” return of the Gen 6 account of angels/Nephilim coming to earth like a sci-fi movie in vehicles as described by Ezekiel: **Ezek 1:19 And when the living creatures went, the wheels went by them: and when the living creatures were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up.** No, I have not gone off the deep end in stating that because I also remember Jesus saying: **Matt 24:37 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.** Nephilim were in the days of Noah as well as a remnant afterward, yet absorbed in union with humankind. Maybe this is not what ushers in the apostasy at all. It could be that all the talk of a pre-tribulation rapture does not happen and Christians who put all of their faith in escaping early are disillusioned in their beliefs and leave God. People dull of hearing “Jesus is coming” and then He doesn't come when they think causing them to stop watching and preparing their hearts yet yield to the lusts of their desires instead...just as those in Noah's day waiting for the deluge that never seemed to happen. What if it was all of the above?! It could be so simple we miss it or so horrendous that we cannot handle it, which seems to fit the word: **Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth**

Many of the details in Revelation have taken place, yet matching history with the wording of that poetic prophecy has taken many forms by varied scholars, so I stick to the timelines that are more distinguishable.

So, here is where we are and the best advice is this: **2 Thess 2:1-2 Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him, 2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.**

**Matt 25:13 Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.**
